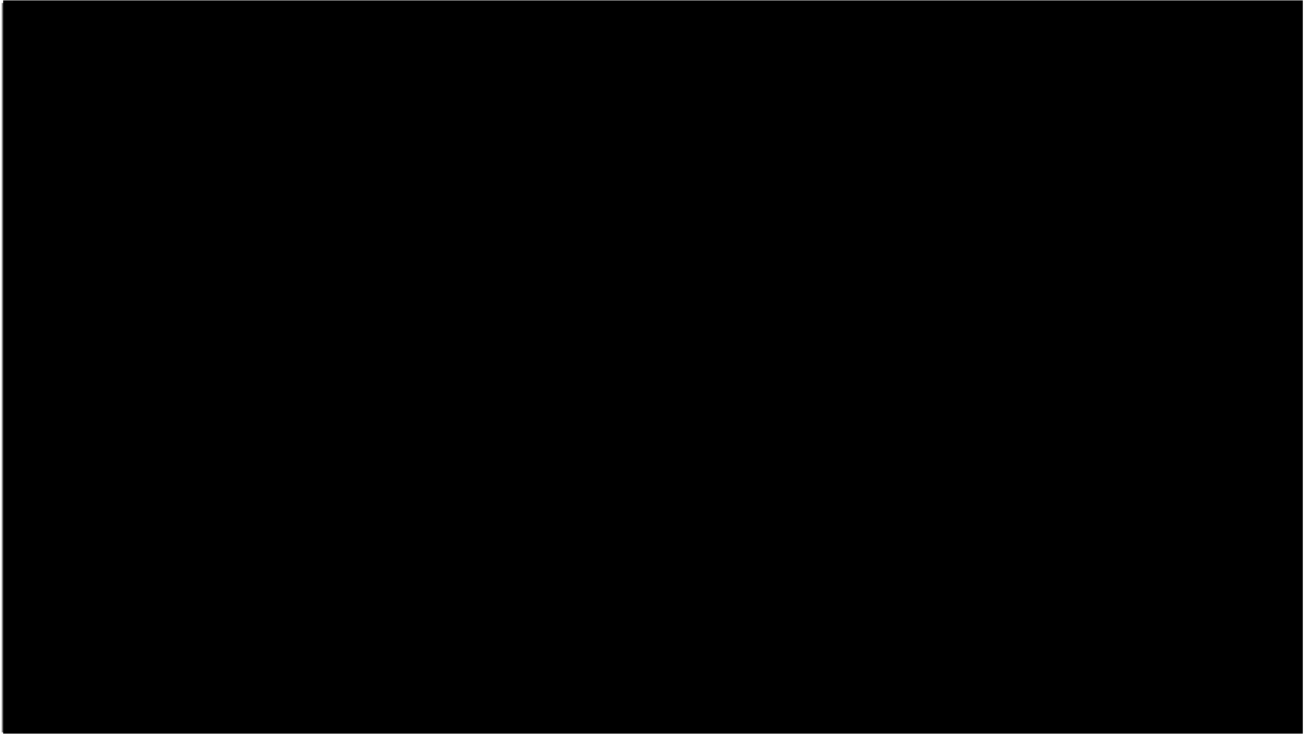

## COUNT 1

The Grand Jurors aforesaid, in the name of and on behalf of the citizens of Georgia, do charge and accuse:

### **MICHAEL JUSTIN WILLIAMS**

with the offense of VIOLATION OF RACKETEER INFLUENCED AND CORRUPT ORGANIZATIONS ACT [O.C.G.A. § 16-14-4(a)], for the said accused, in the State of Georgia and County of Douglas, and elsewhere in the State of Georgia, on and between the 10th day of June, 2025 and the 9th day of July, 2025, did, through a pattern of racketeering activity, unlawfully acquire and maintain, directly and indirectly, any interest in or control of personal property, to wit: packs of Newport cigarettes, belonging to RaceTrac Inc., Family Dollar Stores, Inc., and The Parker Holding Company, LLC [Parker's Kitchen] as described below and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein, contrary to the laws of the State, the good order, peace and dignity thereof.

## **Part I – The Scheme**

Defendant Michael Justin Williams engaged in a pattern of forgeries targeting RaceTrac Inc., Family Dollar Stores, Inc., and The Parker Holding Company, LLC [Parker's Kitchen]. He operated a scheme wherein he would knowingly make, alter, and possess fraudulent coupons for Newport cigarettes. More specifically, Defendant Michael Justin Williams knowingly made, altered, and possessed fraudulent coupons that purported to provide eight dollars [\$8.00] off one [1] pack of Newport cigarettes, when the coupon was properly provided by R.J. Reynolds Tobacco Holdings, Inc. for eight dollars [\$8.00] off one [1] carton of Newport cigarettes. Thus, the fraudulent coupon reduced the cost of one [1] pack of Newport cigarettes to between one dollar [\$1.00] and two dollars [\$2.00] per pack. Defendant Michael Justin Williams traveled to various RaceTrac Inc., Family Dollar Stores, Inc., and The Parker Holding Company, LLC [Parker's Kitchen] store locations where he possessed these fraudulent coupons.

## **Part II – Pattern of Racketeering Activity**

Defendant Michael Justin Williams knowingly and willingly unlawfully engaged in the acts enumerated herein for the common purpose of illegally acquiring personal property, to wit: Newport cigarettes, from RaceTrac Inc., Family Dollar Stores, Inc., and The Parker Holding Company, LLC [Parker's Kitchen] through a pattern of Racketeering Activity. The acts specified herein constitute a "pattern of racketeering activity," in that at least two of the acts were committed in furtherance of one or more incidents, schemes, or transactions that have the same or similar intents, results, accomplices, victims, or methods of commission or otherwise are interrelated by distinguishing characteristics.

**Part III –Acts of Racketeering Activity**

In furtherance of the scheme and to affect its objectives, the Defendant did commit acts, certain of which constitute Racketeering Activity. These acts include, but are not limited to, the following:
