THE GRAND JURORS AFORESAID, IN THE NAME AND BEHALF OF THE CITIZENS OF GEORGIA, further charge and accuse CURESHA BLAIR with the offense of FALSE STATEMENTS AND WRITINGS (O.C.G.A. § 16-10-20), for that the said accused, in the County of Fulton and State of Georgia, on the 10th day of August, 2020, did knowingly and willfully use a false writing knowing the same to contain a false statement and entry in a matter within the jurisdiction of the Georgia Department of Labor, a department of state government, by submitting an online weekly claim certification for the week ending August 8, 2020 falsely stating her income for the said week to the Georgia Department of Labor, contrary to the laws of said State, the good order, peace and dignity thereof.
