COUNT 1: THEFT BY TAKING, O.C.G.A. 16-8-2

in the name of and on behalf of the citizens of the State of Georgia, charge and accuse CARL LEWIS MOTIN, with the offense of THEFT BY TAKING, for that the said CARL LEWIS MOTIN, in the County of Chatham and State of Georgia, on or about the 15th day of April, 2020, did unlawfully take and unlawfully appropriate United States currency, the property of The Department of Revenue, with a value greater than one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) with the intent to deprive said owner of said property, to wit: said accused did cash check number 20162681039, contrary to the laws of the State of Georgia, the good order, peace and dignity thereof.

COUNT 2: THEFT BY TAKING, O.C.G.A. 16-8-2

And the jurors aforesaid, in the name of and on behalf of the citizens of the State of Georgia, further charge and accuse CARL LEWIS MOTIN, with the offense of THEFT BY TAKING, for that the said CARL LEWIS MOTIN, in the County of Chatham and State of Georgia, on or about the 14th day of April, 2020, did unlawfully take and unlawfully appropriate United States currency, the property of The Department of Revenue, with a value of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) or less with the intent to deprive said owner of said property, to wit: said accused did cash check number 2016275166, contrary to the laws of the State of Georgia, the good order, peace and dignity thereof.

COUNT 3: THEFT BY TAKING, O.C.G.A. 16-8-2

And the jurors aforesaid, in the name of and on behalf of the citizens of the State of Georgia, further charge and accuse CARL LEWIS MOTIN, with the offense of THEFT BY TAKING, for that the said CARL LEWIS MOTIN, in the County of Chatham and State of Georgia, on or about the 6th day of March, 2020, did unlawfully take and unlawfully appropriate United States currency, the property of The Department of Revenue, with a value of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) or less with the intent to deprive said owner of said property, to wit: said accused did cash check number 2016091778, contrary to the laws of the State of Georgia, the good order, peace and dignity thereof.
