RE: New Electronic Tobacco Reporting Requirements to the Attorney General's Office

As a Non-Participating Tobacco Product Manufacturer ("NPM") that appears on the Attorney General's List of Compliant Tobacco Product Manufacturers, you must submit a certification to the Georgia Department of Law (also known as the Attorney General) on a quarterly and yearly basis.

Beginning with the 2021 Yearly Certification due May 2, 2022 and the First Quarter 2022 certification due on May 10, 2022, we will be replacing the required quarterly and yearly certifications with an electronic system. Each NPM is required to sign up for a user account and complete a certification by the appropriate quarterly or yearly deadline.
